SIMs Parent App

Thank you to all parents that have down loaded the SIMS App. An invitation link has been emailed to all parents. The new SIMS Parent app will allow you to monitor your child's attendance, achievements, behaviour reports, homework, and test results. As you are aware, we use our 'Behaviour for Learning' grades to reward students, but also to identify where they may need to improve their conduct. All students start afresh each lesson on a BFL Grade 2 moving to a BFL Grade 1, should they show effort and commitment to their learning. More information around our 'Behaviour for Learning' grades can be found on the school website; the app will allow you to see when your child is issued with a BFL grade. Alongside this, you will also have access to their student diary and timetable, giving you greater oversight and assurance over your child's wellbeing and safety.

The hope is that the app will allow us to communicate much faster with you, allowing you to keep up to date with events at the school, such as trips or closures, parents' evenings, after-school sessions, and enable us to effectively communicate the progress your child is making with us. You will be able to use the app to update your contact details so we always have the most up-to-date information in case of emergency.
