Literacy assemblies

This week, our assemblies have had a key focus on Literacy and Reading. Our aim at Moorside High School is to really bring reading to life. Students were informed about the accelerated reader, which can be found in the student planner. Through the Accelerated Reader, students can take the "Quick Quiz", usually 10 questions; or can write a short book review. Both will gain points on the Leadership Pathway. Each week students have DEAR time (Drop Everything and Read) during form, and we are encouraging them to choose a book to read during this time. BorrowBox is a free library app where you can read books and audiobooks on your smart phone or iPad. Download the app from iTunes or GooglePlay Store. This is a sensational time for reading and we have some exciting plans to develop a reading library within the building.

COVID-19

Following a couple of very turbulent years for our young people, we can't help but feel slightly relieved we are slowly getting back to normal. However, we were dealt a very disappointing blow earlier this week, when Public Health Salford recommended the wearing of masks in social and communal areas. However, it is our duty to ensure that staff and students are kept safe in school and that we look after each other. SO please rest assured, we are supporting any advice we are given.

Please can we ask that you continue with lateral flow testing. Over the past 18 months, we have picked up many positive cases, where the child or staff member had no symptoms. These simple tests, whilst not always accurate, are a simple preventative measure to stop further spread. Any positive tests should be reported to MHScovidresults@consilium-at.com and followed up with a PCR test to confirm. Unlike previously, close contacts of a positive case will no longer have to isolate, but in line with Public Health advice, we would encourage you to keep testing, including a PCR and be vigilant for the on-set of symptoms.

Open evening

We are extremely thrilled to welcome our perspective students into Team Moorside on Thursday 7th October 5pm -7pm. Thank you to all our current students who have agreed to support the evening. If your child would like to take part and be an ambassador for Moorside High School, they need to collect a letter from reception and return the confirmation slip signed by a parent/carer.
