Apprenticeship Updates

Y11 apprenticeship vacancies are now starting to be advertised on the National Apprenticeship Website - <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship</u> - pupils seeking an apprenticeship should already be registered on this website and actively searching. Pupils can search for vacancies close to their own postcode – but should always check the job details carefully and the qualifications required.

Y11 school leaver vacancies will have a start date of 25 June 2022 or later, after the official school leaving date.

Several local apprenticeship training providers are holding **open events** to support Y11 school leavers seeking vacancies, and we would encourage pupils to attend if the provider offers relevant training. These are providers that provide apprenticeship qualifications whilst working with local employers to find vacancies and help school leavers get recruited!
