Year 11 students must attend school from 08:30am in full school uniform. They will spend some time in their form groups before going to the sports hall period 1. During period 1, students will be able to enjoy a breakfast together and take part in shirt signing, which has now become a long-standing tradition. Students must bring a spare shirt so they can get staff and peers to sign this. Students will not be allowed to wear the signed shirt, so they must bring a spare. Mrs Copestake is organising this event and we are very much looking forward to celebrating with the Year 11 students, their time at Moorside High School and all the hard work and commitment they have shown in the run up to the external exams.


Student Leadership


