As part of the Geography GCSE Course, we will be visiting North Wales on Monday 4th July 2022 to collect data on coastal processes, and to observe the features of a typical coastal management scheme.

The visit will be an invaluable experience for pupils and give them the chance to collect information required to complete the final exam at the end of the Year 11.

Pupils who do not attend would be unable to directly answer questions on the final third exam about the fieldwork they have carried out.

Pupils will need to meet at the entrance to the school on Deans Road at 8:15am ready to depart at 8.30am and will return to school at approximately 4.00pm. They will need to be suitably equipped for a day outside, including a camera, packed lunch, waterproof coat, and medication if required.
