Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope your child is settling in well to Moorside High School and the transition from primary school has been a positive one. Over the coming weeks, as with previous year groups at Moorside High School, our Year 7 students will start to sit a small number of baseline tests.

These tests will be in place of some of their normal timetabled lessons. Students will complete the tests online, in computer rooms. The tests will run from week commencing 12th September 2022 to Thursday 20th October 2022. Students do not need to worry about these tests or do any preparation or revision. They will be completed in a supported environment and should your child require additional support, this will be put in place. If your child does have any concerns, they should speak to their Head of Year – Mr Williams.

Students will not sit a test every day, but may complete two or three different tests, in any given week. The results of these tests will support teaching staff at Moorside High School have a better understanding of individual students' skills and knowledge. The results of these tests will not be shared with parents due to the nature of the test being more aptitude based. They are merely a baseline for us at school.
