Armistice Day – Friday 11th November

- 8:45am – Minibus pick up from school
- 9am – 9:15am – arrival at Humphrey Booth Resource Centre, 16 – 18 Worsley Road, Swinton, M27 5WW
- 9:15am – 10:30am – Poppy Making activities – this includes paper poppy wreath making, wooden memorial crosses and poppy decorations. All of these have been purchased from Baker Ross. We'll have tables of 4-6 people, including 1 veteran, 1 aspire staff member / school staff and 4 pupils, in our Forget Me Not café area. All Aspire staff are fully DBS checked. The café will not be open to the public at this time.
- 10:30am - 11am walk to Swinton Cenotaph for the 11am memorial service where we will lay a wreath and memorial crosses.
- 11:30am - walk back to school
