Dear Parent/Carer of Year 10 Health and Social Care students,

I am writing to inform you that your son/daughter will be completing an assessment in Health and Social Care lessons over the next 2 weeks.

The assessment is part of the Pearson BTEC Level1/Level 2 Tech Award and students are allowed approximately 6 supervised hours to complete an assignment. The assignment is Component 1: Human Lifespan Development.

The students have been given a copy of the assignment and they have been preparing for the supervised assessment in recent lessons.

During the assessment the students must work independently and should not share their work with other learners. All work must be their own and they must sign a declaration of authenticity to confirm this. If group work or collaboration is permitted, they must produce their own independent responses and evidence for the tasks. Any sources of information, ideas, text, audio and/or visual assets created by others that they include in their work must be clearly identified and referenced. Using the work of others as their own or without proper acknowledgement is considered plagiarism and can result in disqualification from the assessment. They may ask their teacher for support if they have questions about the requirements of tasks, what evidence they need to produce and any resources they are allowed to access, such as their own course notes and access to the internet to source audio/visual content. The teacher cannot give them feedback about how to improve their work or guide them to solutions to any questions or problems in the tasks.

The assessments will be internally marked by the Health and Social Care teachers and the work will then be externally moderated by the exam board.

As always, it is important that that all the students are punctual to their Health and Social Care lessons to maximise the time available to complete the assignment.
