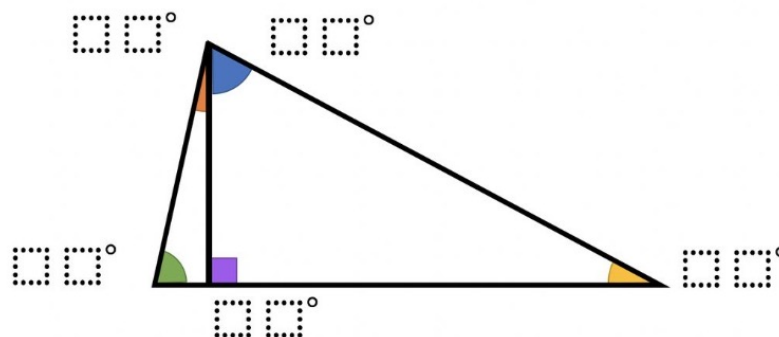
The table shows information about the ages of 90 employees in a factory.
