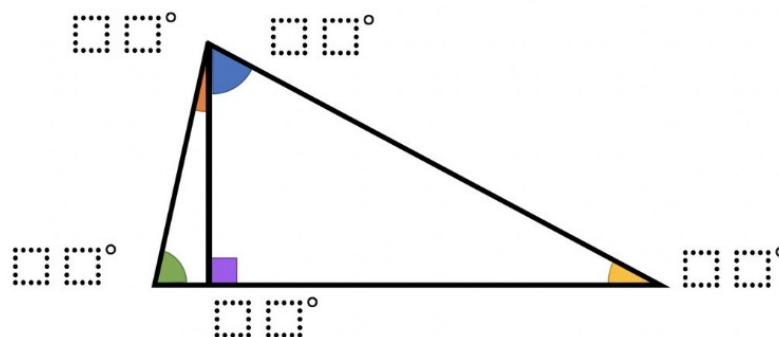
The table shows information about the ages of 90 employees in a factory.

Using the numbers 0 to 9, without repetition, fill in the blanks to determine the possible angles in the triangle below.







