Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware, at this stage of Year 9, it is time to consider students' choices for KS4 and ultimately those subjects they will achieve their first external qualifications in. We know these are big decisions and would like to reassure you that there will be a great deal of support on offer during the Year 9 Choices process.

To help support you and your child in making these important decisions, we would like to invite parents/carers to a **Choices Information Evening** on **Tuesday 30th January 2024 at 5.30pm.**

On this evening, we will talk you through a brief presentation explaining the process and what subjects are available for your child to take. We will also provide you with a Choices Booklet, detailing all the qualifications we offer at KS4 (during Years 10 and 11) – some are compulsory, but there are a number of decisions to be made by your child about those additional subjects they wish to take, this will all be explained on the evening.

Some key dates in the Choices process are:

- **18th January**: **Year 9 Parents' Evening 15:30-18:00.** (This is an extremely important Parents' Evening so that you can be well-informed about your child's progress in their subjects and ask any additional questions you may have about Year 9 Choices). This will be face to face with bookings via school cloud, more information will be circulated nearer the time.
- 30th January: Year 9 Choices Evening. (For parents/carers only) we look forward to seeing you there at 5.30pm.
- 31st January 2nd February: Year 9 Choices assemblies. (These are for students only and will inform students about those subjects at KS4 they won't have studied before or may be unfamiliar with). Please ensure your child is in full attendance all week.
- W/C 5th February: Student Leadership Team to visit forms. The current Year 11 students will present to Year 9 form groups about their option choices, the importance of choosing wisely and how to fill out the options form.
- 4th January 9th February: Year 9 Choices Interviews. (These will take place with either a senior member of staff, a Head of Year, or our Careers Advisor. Your child should carefully think about their choices prior to this interview to get the most from their session).
- **28th February: Deadline for the Year 9 Choices form.** Parents should oversee the completion of this form to ensure they are aware of their child's choices.
