National Careers Week: 3-8 March 2025

National Careers Week is here!

During careers week, there will be an additional focus on careers related learning in school – including careers related trips and visitors in school, which we hope the students enjoy. In addition, we have provided some additional resources that both students and parents might find useful when exploring careers at home:



Morrisby All pupils – from Year 7 to Year 11 – have access to an online career platform called “Morrisby”. This is an interactive resource which can suggest careers or job areas that may interest students in the future based on skills, interests and personality!

For students to log into Morrisby:

If you have already logged in during school time (e.g. in R time) then simply go to www.morrisby.com and enter your login and password. Your login is your school email address. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset this (it will send a link to your school email to create a new password).



If you have never logged in to Morrisby, please follow the steps below:

Step 1 Log into your school Consilium email. If you have forgotten your details....

Your email address will likely be in this format: MHSforename.surname@consilium-at.com

(Same password as you use for school computers)

Open the email from “Morrisby” which should be near the top of your email inbox.

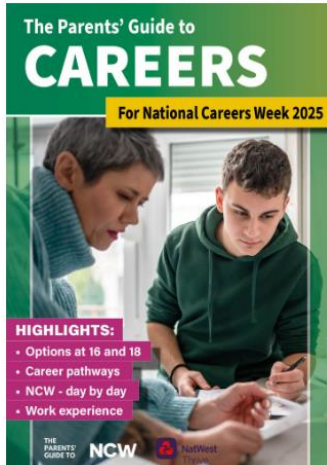
Step 2 Log into Morrisby using the login details provided in your Morrisby email.

You need to login on the Morrisby website: www.Morrisby.com

(When you first login, you will be prompted to change your password – please change this to something you will remember - and write this in your planner or organiser!!)

Once logged in, pupils should complete the various different tasks and quizzes in the “About Me” section to see which career areas may be matched to them and explore job roles! 😊


