Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that all student passes from the last academic year – including toilet passes, time-out passes, early exit passes for anxiety, and medical passes – have now expired.

For the new academic year (2025–2026), any student who requires a pass must provide medical or professional evidence (for example, from a doctor, CAMHS, or another relevant professional). Evidence should be submitted by email to MHSinfo@consilium-at.com.

Pass requests will be reviewed at the start of each half term, and where appropriate, passes will be issued from the first week.

Please be reminded that a child leaving a lesson just 3 minutes early, across 5 lessons a day, 5 days a week, results in significant missed learning time. Over the course of a half term – and across the year – this adds up considerably. For this reason, passes are issued only to those students who genuinely need them.

One of our core school values is resilience. Our aim is to support all students in developing the skills they need for adulthood, while balancing their individual needs with the importance of learning time.

If your child is eligible, their pass will be placed securely within their student planner. Students must show their planner to staff if they need to leave a lesson early. Please note that if a pass is misused or taken advantage of it will be withdrawn, and you will be informed by your child's Head of Year.
