At Moorside, we are always keen to develop our school environment to best meet the needs of our students. With this in mind, we are excited to share that we are relocating our current Mez Room to a new and improved space, which will now be known as the Academic Intervention Centre.

This new space is much larger and has been designed to support students in a variety of ways. It will include:

- A breakout area where students can take time to deregulate.
- Two classroom-style spaces for targeted academic interventions.
- A structured area for students to work if they need to leave a lesson.
- A designated area for use during social times.

Please be assured that the same high standards and expectations remain in place, and all students are still required to follow the Moorside Way.

The Academic Intervention Centre will continue to be accessible to students who are removed from lessons. The current rule of one removal per day remains the same – any further removals will result in students being sent to the removal room. Additionally, if your child has previously accessed this provision during a change of teacher, they will continue to do so while completing their classwork.

The centre will also remain open during break and lunchtimes (with cold food only, as usual).

We believe this development will be a very positive change for our students. Over the coming days, we will gradually introduce these changes to ensure all pupils feel comfortable and confident with the new routines.
