Dear Parent/Carer,

We hope your child is settling in well at Moorside High School and the transition from primary school has been a positive one. Next week (week commencing 15th September), as with previous year groups at Moorside High School, our Year 7 students will start to sit a small number of baseline tests.

These tests will be in place of some of their normal timetabled lessons. Students will complete the tests online, in computer rooms. Students should go to their normal timetabled lessons each day, as their class teacher will lead them down to the computer room should they have a test in that lesson.

Students do not need to worry about these tests or do any preparation or revision. They will be completed in a supported environment and should your child require additional support, this will be put in place. If your child does have any concerns, they should speak to their Head of Year – Mr Williams.

Students will sit one test each day. The results of these tests will support teaching staff at Moorside High School having a better understanding of individual students' skills and knowledge. The results of these tests will not be shared with parents due to the nature of the test being more aptitude based. They are merely a baseline for us at school.
