Timeline: Applying for Year 7 (September 2026)

Date / Stage	What Happens	What Parents Need to Do
September 2025	Applications open via Salford City Council.	Visit salford.gov.uk/schools-admissions . Complete your online form – list Moorside High as one of your 3 preferences.
31 October 2025	Deadline for all Year 7 applications.	Submit your child’s application by this date.
Autumn 2025	SEN/EHC Plan families contacted by the LA.	If your child has an EHC plan, you don’t need to apply online — placement will be arranged through the plan.
1 March 2026 (Offer Day)	Offers issued.	If you applied online, log in to the Family Portal. Paper applicants receive a letter.
By mid-March 2026	Response deadline.	Accept your child’s place within 10 working days to secure it.
April–July 2026	Appeals heard (if applicable).	If refused, submit an appeal within 40 school days of the deadline.

- Type of school: Comprehensive (non-selective, open to all).
- In-year admissions: Apply any time via school.admissions@salford.gov.uk.
- Appeals: Follow Salford Council guidance online.
- Next policy review: September 2026.
