## **Subject: COVID-19 Testing at Moorside High School**

As you are aware, a PCR COVID-19 test centre is set up on the school car park. Due to the increased cases in our school, Salford Public Health have recommended that all family members of our students should be tested. Over the weekend, this test centre will be open 8am-4pm. No appointment is necessary but it will speed up registration for your test if you can book an appointment by calling 119 or <a href="https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test">www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</a>.

If you or a member of family has a positive COVID-19 test, then you and all the household members will be required to isolate for 10 days. If you need to isolate and need support to do this, you can call the Spirit of Salford Helpline on 0800 952 1000 Monday to Friday 8.30am to 6pm and Saturday 9am to 1pm, where you can access practical support for shopping and medication, advice on finances and financial support packages available.

For those who receive a negative COVID-19 result, you should still continue to follow the latest government guidance and legislation:

- meet outside rather than inside where possible
- keep 2 metres apart from people that you don't live with (<u>unless you have formed a support bubble</u> with them)
- minimise travel in and out of Greater Manchester
